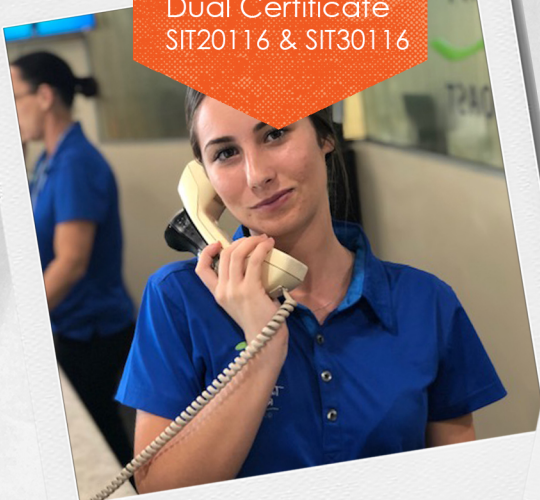

YOUR TRAINING INCLUDES:

- 1x weekly session (approx 2 hrs) at your school, during one school year (minimum 8 students required) suited to your school's requirements.
- Face-to-face classroom delivery with a qualified trainer who has current industry experience.
- Upon completion, graduate with 2 qualifications, a Certificate II AND a Certificate III in Tourism - nationally recognised qualifications.
- Contribution towards ATAR¹ and QCE¹.
- Options available for First Aid or Indigenous culture units. Extra option to participate in the Oceanic Tours experience. We will subsidise some of the cost, making it only \$100 per student to travel to Tangalooma for 2 days and 1 night. Fully supervised!

ELIGIBILITY:

Students must be in Year 10 or 11 to undertake, and a Queensland resident, i.e. Australian Citizen or permanent resident residing in Queensland or a New Zealand citizen permanently residing in Queensland. Students must not have previously completed or be currently enrolled in a Certificate II VETIS Program.

Prestige Service Training is contracted by the Queensland Government to deliver the VET in Schools program - an investment model for the delivery of training to Queensland participants which will provide a Government Subsidy toward the training cost to eligible participants. Please note: Once a Certificate II level qualification has been completed under the VETIS Program Funding, students will no longer be eligible for subsidised training place under the VETIS Program.
