Reliable internet, basic computer skills, and access to necessary software are essential. Online students need a camera and microphone. Full eligibility and enrolment requirements are available at pst.edu.au. Successful completion of the Certificate IV in Justice Studies is highly recommended for enrolling in the Diploma of Justice Studies.
